Green day

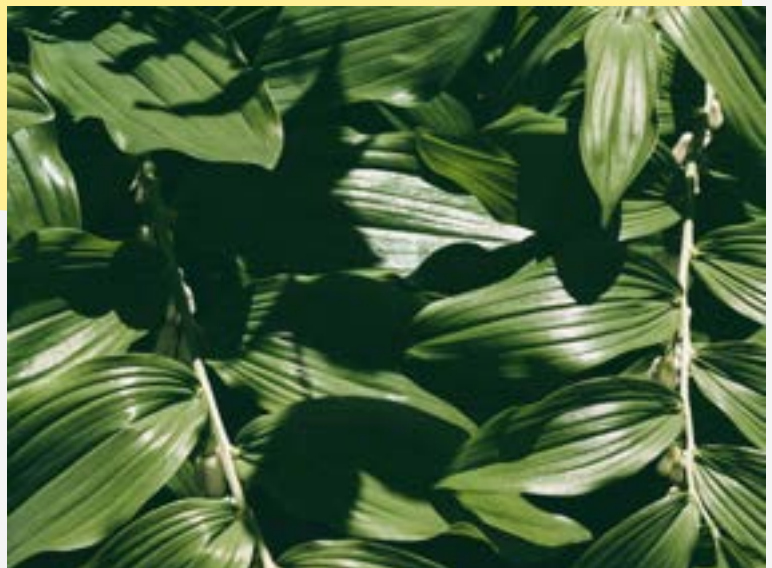


Green denotes nature, and our love towards the environment. Green Day was celebrated with great zeal and enthusiasm by our tiny tots.

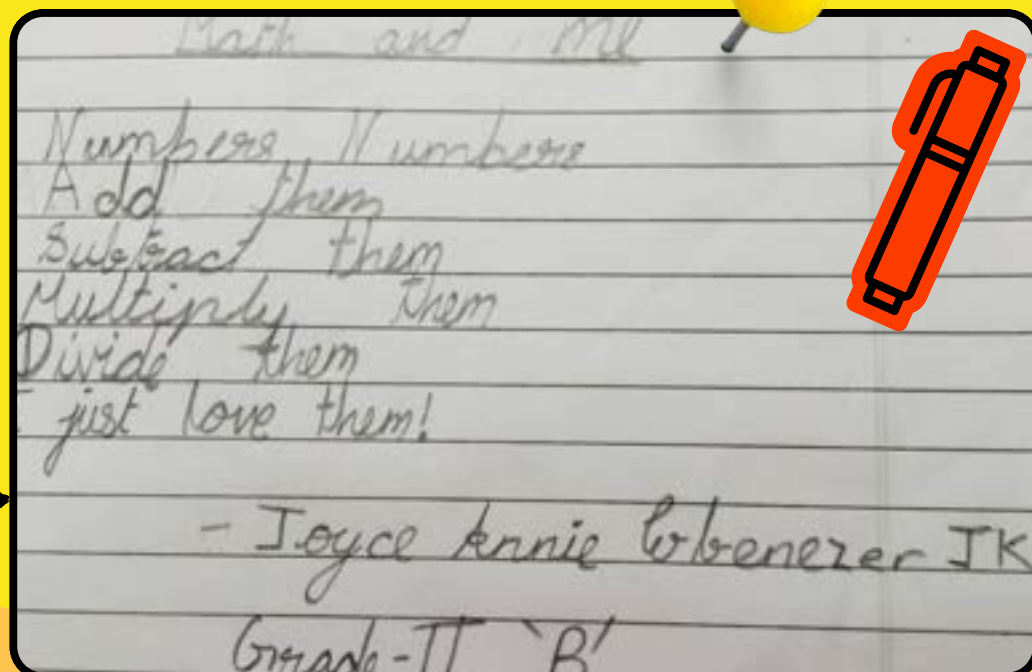
THE QUEEN AND THE DUCK

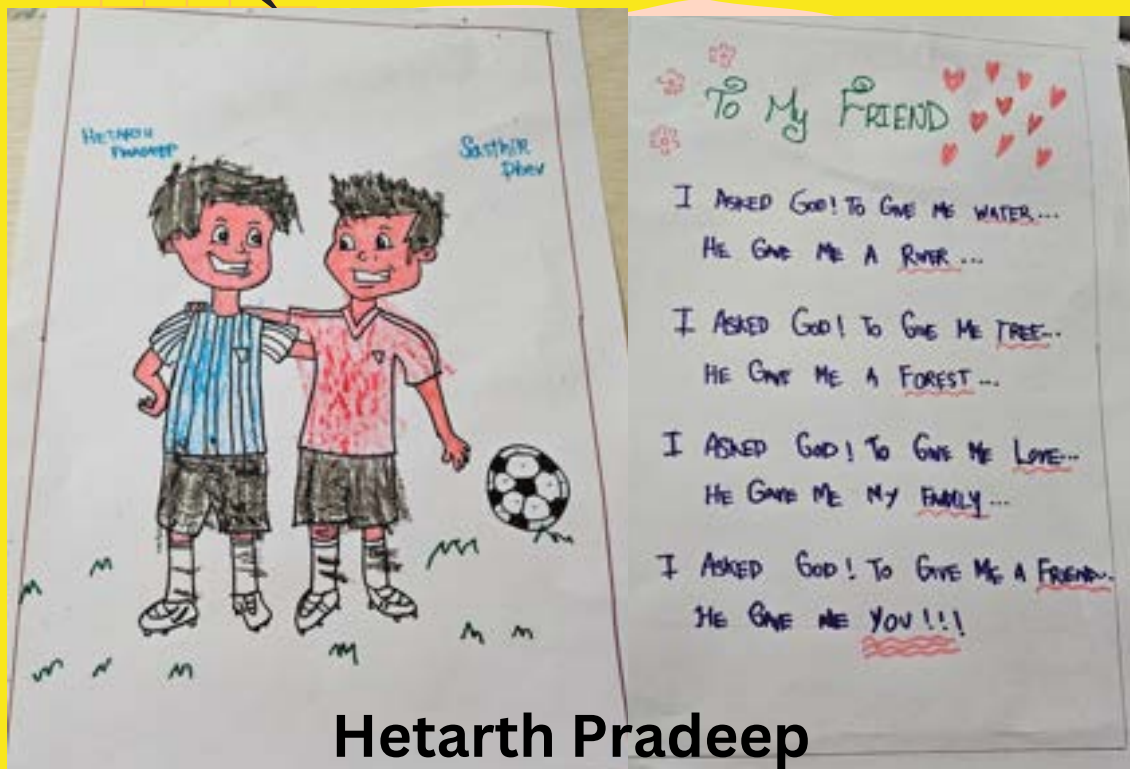

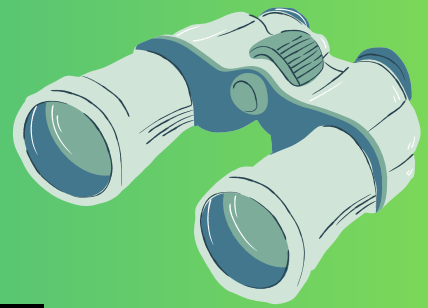
Learning beyond the confines of the classroom has its own charm. It offers students an opportunity to interact with classmates and teachers in a more informal environment.

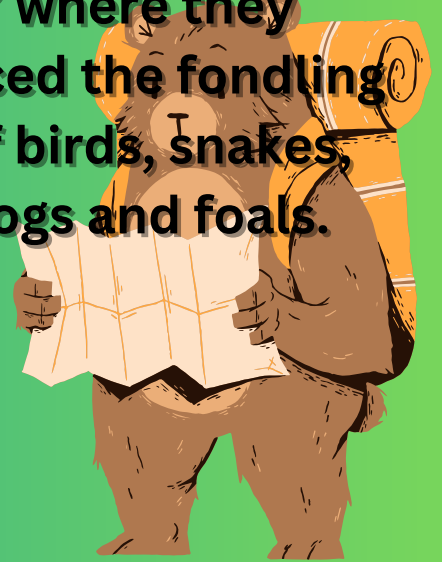
We believe in holistic growth of students. Our KG-1 students went on a field trip to Blaack Forest as a part of extended learning based on the theme “who we are”.

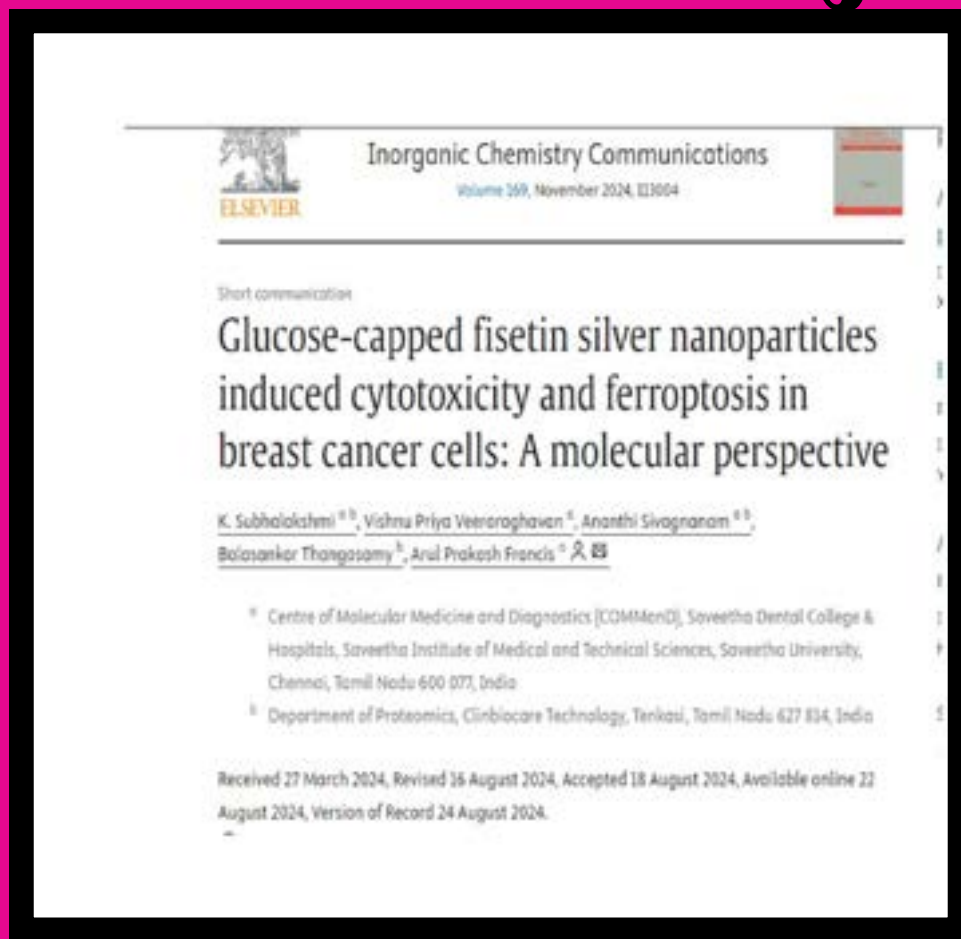


“The world is full of adventure- all you have to do is find it....”
